

INDIAN CREEK NATURE CENTER

Nature Trails and Ski Trails

The Indian Creek Nature Center is located in the Town of Canton. It exists on the Upper and Lower Lakes Wildlife Management Area, which is managed by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.

There are several different trails at this location. One trail begins at the parking area and runs southwesterly to an observation tower and a bird blind overlooking the refuge.

The construction of a boardwalk to make the Nature trail handicapped accessible began in 1989 by the Canton crew of the Youth Conservation Corps. The following summer, all six of the St Lawrence County Youth Conservation Corp crews aided in the construction of the boardwalk facility. The project was finally completed during the 1991 summer session of the YCC by the Canton crew. This crew also aided the Indian Creek Nature Center Association in the placement and construction of a learning center on the center's grounds.

Directions

Taking State Road 68 out of Canton towards Ogdensburg finds the Indian Creek Nature Center. On the left, approximately 4 miles outside Canton, take County Route 14 towards Rensselaer Falls. The entrance to the Center will be on the left-hand side of route 14.
