



**CENSUS 2000, PUBLIC LAW 94-171
PL-T1: POPULATION CHANGE FOR NEW YORK
LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS: 1990 TO 2000**

The data presented in this report are derived from the 1990 and 2000 Censuses of Population and Housing. Counts are presented for the total population and population change between the Census dates for all units of local government. The governmental units are ordered alphabetically by town/city within each county. Village summaries follow the town in which they are included. Town summaries include the population of all villages.

NOTE: Some villages and cities in New York are split by county boundaries and the individual parts are shown in this report and indicated as "(pt.)." Data for the individual parts of villages split by town boundaries are not available on the PL94-171 data file. Totals for these split villages are included at the beginning of each county listing.

CENSUS ADJUSTMENT:

The U.S. Department of Commerce has determined that these data will not be adjusted for Census under- or over-enumeration. These data are final and official Census results.
